House rules

We want Sea Glass Cottage to feel easy for you and for the neighbors next door. A few simple guidelines keep it that way.

- Quiet hours run from 10 PM to 8 AM.
- Rinse off sand at the outdoor shower before heading inside.
- Smoking is welcome on the back deck only.
- Two guests per bedroom keeps the cottage comfortable.
- Pets are welcome with a heads-up before you arrive.

Amenities

Kitchen

- Espresso machine, with pods in the drawer to the left of the stove.
- Full gas range for anyone who wants to cook a real dinner.
- Dishwasher tabs are under the sink.

Beach gear

- Four beach chairs, an umbrella, and a cooler in the garage.
- Boogie boards hang on the hooks by the garage door.



Quirks of the home

The front door sticks a little in humid weather. Lift up gently on the handle while you turn the key and it opens right away.

The guest bathroom tap runs hot after about 30 seconds, so give it a moment before you hop in.

The ceiling fan remote lives on the fridge, held on by a magnet, so it never wanders far.

Getting here

From Miami International Airport, Sea Glass Cottage is about a 25-minute drive east, straight down the 836 toward the beach.

Cross the Julia Tuttle Causeway and follow the signs for Miami Beach; the cottage sits three blocks north of the first light past the water.

Park in the gravel strip beside the hedge. The paved driveway next door belongs to our neighbor.

Parking

The driveway fits two cars comfortably, nose to the garage.

Street parking is open after 6 PM and all day on weekends; check the signs for weekday restrictions before then.

Cars parked in front of the neighbor's driveway get towed quickly, so please stick to our driveway or the marked street spots.

Local favorites

Eat

- Joe's Stone Crab (Seafood restaurant, 0.2 mi away) — A Miami Beach institution since 1913. Go early, put your name down, and order the stone crab with the mustard sauce. 11 Washington Ave, Miami Beach, FL 33139, USA · (305) 673-0365
- MILA (Mediterranean restaurant, 1.5 mi away) — Rooftop, Mediterranean and Japanese on one menu. Book ahead and ask for a table on the terrace. 1636 Meridian Ave Rooftop, Miami Beach, FL 33139, USA · (786) 706-0744
- Smith & Wollensky - Miami Beach (Steak house, 0.2 mi away) — Steak with the cruise ships sliding past the window. Worth it for sunset alone. 1 Washington Ave, Miami Beach, FL 33139, USA · (305) 673-2800

Coffee

- Pura Vida - South Beach (Coffee shop, 0.2 mi away) — Our morning stop. Acai bowls, good flat whites, and a five minute walk from the front door. 110 Washington Ave Apt 2, Miami Beach, FL 33139, USA · (305) 535-4142
- Café Bastille Miami Beach (Brunch restaurant, 0.5 mi away) — French breakfast done properly. The croissants sell out by ten. 538 Washington Ave, Miami Beach, FL 33139, USA · (786) 425-3575

Groceries

- 7-Eleven (Convenience store, 0.7 mi away) — Open all night for the things you forgot. Two blocks up Ocean Drive. 890 Washington Ave, Miami Beach, FL 33139, USA · (305) 532-5007
- Publix Super Market at Fifth & Alton (Supermarket, 0.7 mi away) — The full shop, ten minutes on foot. Free parking if you drive. 1100 6th St, Miami Beach, FL 33139, USA · (305) 535-2212

Do

- South Pointe Park (Park, 0.2 mi away) — Our favorite walk. Grassy lawns, a beach with calm water, and the best people watching on the island. 1 Washington Ave, Miami Beach, FL 33139, USA · (305) 673-7730

- CVS Pharmacy (Pharmacy, 0.4 mi away) — Sunscreen, bandages, painkillers. Open late every day. 555 Washington Ave, Miami Beach, FL 33139, USA · (305) 673-4149
- Shell (Gas station, 0.5 mi away) — Nearest fuel, and the closest cash machine to the cottage. 845 5th St, Miami Beach, FL 33139, USA · (305) 672-5577

Coffee

- Panther Coffee — strong espresso and easy parking, six minutes away.
- Nomad Tribe — good pastries and a quiet patio for the morning.

Dinner

- Lulu's Bait Shack — casual seafood right on the water.
- La Sandwicherie — the sandwich stop everyone in the neighborhood loves.
- Byblos — the pick for a nicer night out.

Beach day

- South Pointe Park — calm water, a short walk from the cottage.
- Lummus Park Beach — livelier, with rentals for chairs and umbrellas.



Getting around

Rideshares pick up best from the curb at the end of the driveway — that spot has the clearest signal for the driver's app.

The South Beach trolley runs along Collins Avenue every 10 to 15 minutes and is free to ride.

Bike rentals are available at the kiosk two blocks south, a nice way to cover the beach without a car.

Groceries

Publix is six minutes away by car and carries everything for a full week of meals.

A small farmers market sets up on Sunday mornings a few blocks north, worth a walk for fresh produce.

The 24-hour pharmacy on Alton Road covers anything you forgot to pack.

Emergency info

For any emergency, call 911 first.

The nearest urgent care is Mount Sinai Urgent Care at 4300 Alton Road, about 10 minutes away.

A fire extinguisher is under the kitchen sink, and the breaker panel is in the laundry room.

Check-out

Check-out by 11:00 AM

- Start the dishwasher
- Bag the trash and take it to the bin by the driveway

FAQ

Is there parking?

Yes — the driveway fits two cars, and street parking opens up after 6 PM.

Do you have a beach pass or beach gear?

Beach chairs, an umbrella, and a cooler are in the garage, ready to go.

Can we check in early?

Early check-in depends on our cleaning schedule — message us the morning of your stay and we will let you know.

Are extra towels available?

Extra towels are folded in the hallway closet, right above the wifi router.

What are the pool hours?

The cottage has no pool. South Pointe Park and Lummus Park Beach are both a short walk away.
